CASINO

The Casino is provided by Carolina Casino Connection Tables available are as follows: 1 Craps Table with 16 seats 1 Roulette Table with 8 seats 6 Blackjack Tables with 7 seats (total of 42 seats) 1 Texas Holdem Table with 9 seats Seat donations will be \$10.00 each

"Casino money" will accompany your ticket. Additional 'money' will be available. The big winners from each separate game (1 for Craps; 1 for Roulette; 1 for Blackjack; 1 for Texas Holdem) will receive a special prize.

DIAMOND DIP

For a donation of \$25.00, all attendees over the age of 21, will be able to purchase a glass of champagne. All champagne glasses will be numbered. Each champagne glass will contain either a ½ carat unmounted diamond (One SI clarity, G color GIA 5.01 MM x 5.04 MM x 3.13 MM round brilliant cut diamond, estimated retail value \$2,300.00) round cut GIA certified clarity G) or a ½ carat Cubic Zirconia. The diamond is courtesy of *Main Street Jewelers*, 236 East Main Street in downtown Clayton. We will announce between 9:00 and 9:30 the glass number containing the ½ carat diamond. The lucky person holding the diamond will also receive a \$200.00 gift certificate from Main Street Jewelers in Clayton for mounting. Only one diamond will be available.

REVERSE RAFFLE

The Reverse Raffle will have a grand prize of \$10,000.00. Additionally, there are 'Second Chance' opportunities to win. Winning draws are detailed below

First ticket drawn will receive \$500.00 Each 25th ticket drawn (25, 50, 75, etc.) will receive \$100.00 Third to last ticket drawn (if remaining holders do NOT decide to split the winnings) will receive \$500.00 Second to last ticket drawn (if a split option is NOT done) will receive \$750.00 Last ticket holder will receive \$10,000.00

Reverse Raffle need not be present to win. All drawing prizes will be paid from the ticket proceeds. The first drawn ticket will receive \$500.00 *or* he/she may elect to put ticket back in the tumbler in lieu of the \$500.00 prize.

Reverse Raffle Rules

The Grand Prize Drawing for this event will be held on Saturday, November 9, 2019 around 10:00pm at The Farm at 42, Hwy 42 East about 1 mile past Percy Flowers Store.

Ticket cost is \$100.00 each. The ticket price is not tax-deductible.

You must be 18 years or older to purchase a Reverse Raffle Ticket. Woman's Club members ARE eligible to participate in the Reverse Raffle.

Tickets are considered purchased when complete payment of \$100.00 for each ticket has been received and recorded by the Woman's Club of Clayton.

A maximum of 400 tickets will be sold. Each Reverse Raffle ticket will be sequentially numbered and will have a detachable portion. One portion will go into the tumbler and the purchaser will keep the other portion. The portion of the ticket deposited into the tumbler will include the purchaser's printed name, address and phone

number. Tickets purchased online through the Woman's Club of Clayton website before October 25th will be mailed to the purchaser. Tickets purchased online after October 25th will be available at the Registration Desk the night of the event. The website will notify the purchaser of their completed purchase after the purchase is completed. Online ticket purchases must be by credit or debit card. Tickets purchased from Woman's Club of Clayton members may be by cash or check. **Tickets purchased on the night of the event must be made by <u>cash or check.</u>**

Throughout the evening, numbers are pulled at random from a tumbler. As each number is pulled, that ticket is removed from the display, thus eliminating that ticket holder from the Grand Prize drawing. The winner of the Grand Prize need not be present to win.

Ticket purchases will cease on Saturday, November 9[,] 2019 at 7:00pm

The final 10 ticket holders will have the opportunity to decide whether to continue with the raffle or split the Grand Prize. If there is an agreement to stop and split the prize, the Grand Prize will be divided between the 10 ticket holders. If one or more remaining ticket holders do not want to split, the raffle will continue and another ticket will be drawn. From this point forward, the remaining ticket holders can split the Grand Prize. If a ticket holder is not present, it will be assumed that the holder wants to continue the raffle unless they have indicated on the ticket stub that they want to split and the type of splits they are willing to do (split with 2 people, 5 people or 10 people).

Businesses, companies, and non-profit organizations may purchase a ticket or several people can share the cost of a ticket. However, only one person must be named as the 'Ticket Owner.' The Ticket Owner controls the ticket and is responsible for sharing the proceeds with his/her co-purchasers.

In the event of a dispute or controversy, Judy Ryan, Small Town Gala Co-Chair will rule.

Winners are solely responsible for any and all taxes due on the awards.

All cash prize winners must make available their social security number for tax reporting.

All cash prize winners will be mailed within 3 business days after the event to the name and address on the ticket. No exceptions will be made.
